Alamosa Credit Union

Location: Alamosa, CO

Type of Institution: Credit Union

Target Market(s): A two-county Investment Area comprised of Alamosa and Rio Grande Counties, Colorado.

Alamosa Credit Union was chartered in 1945 as Alamosa Hispanic Credit Union to serve the Hispanic population of Alamosa County. Several merges and many years later, Alamosa Credit Union now serves a trade area that includes both Alamosa and Rio Grande counties. Services offered by the credit union include savings, checking and investment accounts, vehicle, equipment and real estate loans, money orders and Western Union wire services.

Butte Federal Credit Union

Location: Biggs, CA

Type of Institution: Credit Union

Target Market(s): A 66 census tract Investment Area in the Counties of Butte, Tehama, Glenn, Colusa, Sutter, Yuba and Plumas in California.

Butte Federal Credit Union, chartered in 1935 as Butte Pomona Credit Union, has expanded its membership over the years to serve all of Butte, Colusa, Glenn, Plumas, Sutter, Tehama and Yuba counties. Their philosophy, "People Helping People," is exemplified by the range of services that they offer: savings and checking accounts, personal, vehicle and real estate loans, and traveler's cheques and money orders.

The Bank of Bonifay

Location: Bonifay, FL

Type of Institution: Bank or Thrift

Target Market(s): A 13 census tract Investment Area in Holmes, Jackson, Washington, Walton, and Bay Counties of Florida.

The Bank of Bonifay, the oldest active state chartered bank in the state of Florida, was incorporated and chartered in 1906. Over time, the bank's trade area has expanded to include Jackson, Washington, Holmes, Bay, Walton, and Okaloosa Counties. Services offered include savings accounts, personal and student checking accounts, personal and commercial loans, and both traditional and Roth IRAs.

Tombstone Federal Credit Union

Location: Tombstone, AZ

Type of Institution: Credit Union

Target Market(s): A 15 census tract Investment Area in Cochise County, Arizona; Low-Income Targeted Population in Cochise County, Arizona.

Tombstone Federal Credit Union (Tombstone FCU), chartered in 1956, serves the community of Cochise County, Arizona. Tombstone FCU offers services that include savings and checking accounts, personal, vehicle, construction and business loans, wire transfers, and free local ATM access.
