



Thank you for your willingness to test CIMS5 prior to the official go-live.


How to Use

To get started, naviagate to the test site, <u>here</u>, and choose one of the Programs via the Program dropdown.






Use the search bar to type an address or longitude/latitude, and view eligibility information on the map.
