# COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS PROGRAM

Access to affordable financial products and services is a staple of economically sound communities. Yet at least one quarter of American households do not have bank accounts or rely on costly payday lenders and check-cashing outlets. In recent years, the lack of access to capital investments for small businesses and other critical community development projects has also led to increased need for alternative and reliable sources of financing.

Mission-driven organizations called Community Development Financial Institutions—or CDFIs—fill these gaps by offering affordable financial products and services that meet the unique needs of economically underserved communities. Through awards and trainings, the Community Development Financial Institutions Program (CDFI Program) invests in and builds the capacity of CDFIs, empowering them to grow, achieve organizational sustainability, and contribute to the revitalization of their communities.

## THE CDFI PROGRAM PROVIDES BOTH FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AWARDS:

Financial Assistance (Base-FA) awards of up to \$1 million allow CDFIs to sustain and expand their financial products and services. CDFIs that qualify for Base-FA funding must match this award with funds from a non-federal source. Base-FA awards can be used for lending capital, loan loss reserves, capital reserves, financial services, and development services to achieve at least one of the following FA objectives:

- Increase volume of products or services
- Provide new products or services
- Expand operations into new geographic areas
- Service new targeted populations

The FY 2021 application emphasized the extent of economic distress in the areas CDFIs are serving; the extent to which their activities have expanded, or will expand, economic opportunities; and the extent to which CDFIs will collaborate with their communities and increase their resources through collaborations and partnerships.

Technical Assistance (TA) awards of up to \$125,000 are used for capacity development that is integral to CDFIs' organizational sustainability and success. CDFIs often use these awards to purchase equipment, hire consulting or contracting services, pay salaries and benefits, or train staff or board members.

The CDFI Program also administers the Persistent Poverty Counties-Financial Assistance (PPC-FA), Disability Funds-Financial Assistance (DF-FA), and Healthy Food Financing Initiative-Financial Assistance (HFFI-FA) awards. These initiatives serve as supplemental funding opportunities under the CDFI Program and Native American CDFI Assistance Program for eligible CDFIs that receive Base-FA awards.

KEY STATISTICS OF AWARDED ORGANIZATIONS (FA AND TA AWARDS COMBINED):

422 ORGANIZATIONS RECEIVED \$188.5 MILLION IN AWARDS.

210 LOAN FUNDS, 159 CREDIT UNIONS, 47 BANKS/HOLDING COMPANIES, AND 6 VENTURE CAPITAL FUNDS RECEIVED AWARDS.

THE ORGANIZATIONS AWARDED WERE HEADQUARTERED IN 43 STATES, THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, AND PUERTO RICO.



# FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AWARD HIGHLIGHTS:

## KEY STATISTICS OF FY 2021 BASE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE APPLICANTS

For the fiscal year (FY) 2021 funding round of the CDFI Program, the CDFI Fund received applications from 420 organizations requesting \$366.1 million in Financial Assistance (Base-FA) awards. Of those applicants, 316 Core applicants requested \$304.7 million in awards, and 104 Small and/or Emerging CDFI (SECA) applicants requested \$61.4 million in awards.


## LOANS AS MATCHING FUNDS

The CDFI Fund matches all eligible loans provided as non-Federal matching funds with a standard loan product under the Base-FA component. The standard loan product is a fixed-rate, 13-year loan with interest-only payments in years one through ten, providing essential low-cost, long-term capital to CDFIs. With a subsidy rate of 12.615 percent, the CDFI Program is helping the federal government to stretch its resources even further.

## THE FY 2021 FA AWARDEES OPERATE IN ALL 50 STATES



Combined, the FY 2021 CDFI Program Financial Assistance awardees operate in all 50 states, the District of Columbia, American Samoa, Guam, Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands. This coverage includes their certified Target Markets as well as their other areas of operation. The above map illustrates the number of awardees operating in each state. Combined, the FY 2021 Financial Assistance awardees have a total of \$50.1 billion invested in the 50 states and the District of Columbia and \$1.5 billion invested in the territories.

### PERSISTENT POVERTY COUNTIES\*

Persistent Poverty Counties (PPCs) are defined as counties where 20% or more of the population has lived in poverty over the past 30 years. These counties can be found in the United States in both rural and urban areas.

For the FY 2021 round, 125 CDFIs received \$18.6 million in CDFI Program Persistent Poverty Counties-Financial Assistance (PPC-FA) awards specifically to serve PPCs. In addition, 57 organizations headquartered in PPCs received \$7.1 million in CDFI Program Technical Assistance awards.

### DISABILITY FUNDS

The CDFI Fund received applications from 24 organizations requesting \$10.9 million in Disability Funds-Financial Assistance (DF-FA).

#### KEY STATISTICS OF FY 2021 DF-FA AWARDEES:

- 14 organizations received \$6 million in awards.
- Awardees consisted of 10 loan funds, 2 bank/bank holding companies, and 2 credit unions.
- 8 awardees primarily serve major urban markets, 1 primarily serves a micropolitan area, 3 primarily serve minor urban markets, and 2 primarily serve rural markets.

DF-FA awardees will use the funds to enhance their capacity to address the challenges of individuals with disabilities, such as: asset development; affordable, accessible, and safe housing; employment opportunities; or access to assistive products and services that support health and community living.

### HEALTHY FOOD FINANCING INITIATIVE

The CDFI Fund received applications from 26 organizations requesting \$76.6 million in Healthy Food Financing Initiative-Financial Assistance (HFFI-FA).

#### KEY STATISTICS OF FY 2021 HFFI-FA AWARDEES:

- 10 organizations received \$23 million in awards.
- Awardees consisted of 9 loan funds and 1 bank/bank holding company.
- 7 awardees primarily serve major urban markets and 3 primarily serve minor urban markets.

HFFI-FA awardees will use the funds to enhance their capacity to make investments in a range of retail and non-retail healthy food projects serving low income communities, including food production, grocery stores, mobile food retailers, farmers markets, cooperatives, corner stores, bodegas, and others.

\*The Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021 (P.L. 116-260) mandated that no less than 10% of the appropriated funds for the CDFI Program must support investments in Persistent Poverty Counties.


# TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AWARD HIGHLIGHTS:
